8.1 Block slashing policy

Stefan Glockner spoke to the block-slashing proposal, and moved

“That the community adopts the blockslashing procedure set out below

Blockslashing procedure

The Community Corporation feels that regular lot slashing is required at the Arts EcoVillage to:

- adequately control the weeds on the EcoVillage site
- improve the safety of the site in terms of fire and snake risks
- improve the look of the village.

All lot holders to have their vacant lots slashed by the dates outlined below.

20th of Sept

The early September cut is important as it deals with many of the high broadleaf weeds. They need to be slashed to keep the weeds down and prevent them from seeding.

30th Oct

A maintenance cut of broad leaves and grass down for weed management and safety.

30th Nov or before the grasses become dry

This should be the final slash. Most vegetation consists of grasses that would seed well next year. This slash will also cut the heads off some of the germinating summer weeds

If your block has not been slashed by these cut off dates, the community corporation will carry out the slashing required and bill the lot owner(s) \$50 per slash per block.”
